Rules for ACC Home Schoolers Martial Arts Program

- 1. Loose fitting clothes with a shirt that can be tucked in, are proper attire for class.
- 2. Body pads for Karate are required for sparring. We have a few that can be borrowed. Mouth guards are mandatory, cups are highly recommended for boys during sparring.
- 3. Loud talking is not permitted during class.
- 4. If you arrive late for class you must report to the instructor and ask permission to join the class. The instructor will inform you what must be done to join class.
- 5. Proper respect and discipline shall be maintained at all times.
- 6. No one shall leave a class in progress without requesting permission from the instructor.
- 7. Students and spectators are not to eat, drink, or chew gum in the class room (water is an exception).
- 8. No horse play or foul language is allowed.
- 9. Students should be mindful of ACC Home Schoolers equipment and facility to keep it clean and in good condition.
- 10. Do not wear jewelry during class.
- 11. Keep longer hair tied back.
- 12. Keep finger nails and toe nails well-trimmed.
- 13. Be on time for class.
- 14. When line up is called all talking will stop. This is time for instruction and students must listen.
